Vaccination Policy

All **Cape Symphony** concert attendees at the **Barnstable** Performing Arts Center will be required to provide proof of vaccination and identification upon arrival at every performance, with exceptions for children ages six to 12 (age restrictions per our age policy) and people with a medical condition or closely held religious belief that prevents vaccination.

Attendees who fall into one of these exception categories, **including children**, must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test (either a PCR test taken within 72 hours of the performance start time, or an antigen test taken within 24 hours of the performance start time). COVID-19 tests must be administered by a third party. Self-administered tests (like an at-home kit from a drugstore) will not be accepted. Note that we won't ask you to identify why you fall into an exception category.

Proof of full vaccination is defined as two weeks after your final shot against COVID-19, either in the form of a physical vaccination card or a photo of the card.

Please do not email your proof in advance; everyone will be required to stop at the check-in table.

All attendees will need to enter the **Barnstable** Performing Arts Center through the front door facing West Main Street. We'll have staff stationed at the entrance to greet you. Please plan to arrive early if possible
