Replacing the existing Alphonso Elder Student Union, the new building includes a large multi-use gathering space seating up to 1,000 for conferences and banquets, small and medium sized conference rooms, administrative offices for student union operations, and office space for student organizations.







Fulfilling the 2008 Campus Master Plan and 2012 Student Housing Master Plan, the new Kahlert Village student housing project will add a total of 992 beds to its first-year housing inventory. The facility will feature communities of 36 and 40 students, lounges, living rooms, kitchens and laundry facilities, as well as a 650-seat dining facility designed to welcome all members of the University community.



The Human Performance Center features dual-use academic spaces, state-of-the-art laboratories, and areas shared by faculty and students. It features spaces filled with natural light, visibility into activity areas and the surrounding campus, public lounges, and activity zones that provide opportunities for learning and hands-on training. The academic portion includes classrooms, teaching labs, offices, conference spaces.

Gardner Commons is a state-of-the-art facility located in the heart of the U of U campus. 


As a destination, it is marked by its welcoming transparent embrace toward lower campus.
